

Call for Application
The JADE Grant for Overseas Travels of Young Researchers

1. Objectives

The JADE Grant for Overseas Travels of Young Researchers (hereafter, this grant) is provided to young JADE members for their travel costs to present their works in overseas conferences. We will select maximum two members this fiscal year (October 1, 2023-September 30, 2024) up to 100,000JPY each. Those winners of this grant are selected according to the quality of papers of the applicants and the quality and status of the conferences they participate in. When presented papers are coauthored with others, how the papers are evaluated is determined by the selection committee.

2. Eligibility

The winner of this grant should satisfy all of the following conditions.

- A regular or student member at the time of applying for and winning the grant.
- A researcher in development economics being currently affiliated or having been affiliated with a university, research institution, or related organization in Japan.
- A researcher who does not receive any research grant from a public or private institution, such as Kakenhi, except for salaries and honorariums, at the time of applying for and winning the grant.
- A researcher who will present or presented a paper authored by the researcher (including one coauthored by the researcher) in a conference held overseas (outside of Japan) during the same fiscal year of JADE (from October to September) as the application period.

3. Application and Selection Process

- An applicant will submit the name and place of conference, the title and author(s) of the paper along with the full accepted paper, estimated (actual) travel costs (based on an invoice/receipt), and any material that proves the acceptance of presentation (e.g., email) by **December 15, 2023** to info@jade.gr.jp.
- JADE selection committee members will evaluate the application and decide the maximum two successful winners. Payment will be made after the presentation.
- JADE board members will notify the successful winners on the JADE website.
